## 20. TURAIDA MUSEUM RESERVE

The most visited museum of Latvia offers expositions on the history of archaeology, culture and art and narrates events dating back as far as to the 11th century. The collection of the museum keeps many stories – about the medieval castle and church, the Livs of the River Gauja, the ancient centre of the manor and Dainu Kalns (Folksong Hill). ## 4. SIGULDA SPORTS CENTRE

Multifunctional sports centre with modern sports equipment, 25 m long swimming pool, weightlifting hall and a gym, as well as a 100 m running track. Families with children will enjoy a Water and Recreation Park with two water slides, three different baths, SPA bath, opposite stream pool, and water attractions for children. ## 9. WALKING STICK PARK

The walking stick park is a dedication to the oldest and best recognised symbol of Sigulda – the wooden walking stick. The first historical mention of the walking stick can be found in travel guides of the 19th century, which say “a walking stick, which can be bought from a local boy, may come in handy while walking through the valleys of Sigulda”. The visitors of Sigulda Castle District are invited to visit a walking stick workshop to make their own souvenir – a walking stick. It is located on the corner of Cēsu and Jāņa Poruka streets. ## 7. LIVONIAN ORDER SIGULDA CASTLE

The Livonian order Castle of Sigulda was built in 1207 as a castella type castle, however, it was later rebuilt into a convent type building. A contemporary seeker of medieval aura can climb the northern and main gate tower of the castle. An open-air stage located in the centre of the castle hosts concerts and festivals, including the International Sigulda Opera Music Festival. 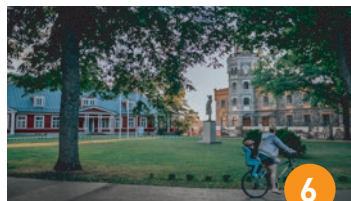
## 16., 17. KRIMULDA MANOR. KRIMULDA MEDIEVAL CASTLE RUINS

The residential house of Firsts Lievens was built in around 1822 in the style of classicism. The manor complex features the manager's house, coach house, cattle yard, Swiss House, etc. For 95 years already, a rehabilitation institution, which offers accommodation services as well, has been operating at the manor. Tasting events of fruit and floral wines are offered to the guests of the manor by prior arrangement. Krimulda Medieval Castle ruins are situated nearby. ## 25. ADVENTURE PARK MEŽAKAKIŠ.

The first adventure park in Latvia to offer an obstacle course in the trees. Here you can try overcoming obstacles on the ropes, nets, bridges, swings, ladders, as well as feel the wind on a long slide, while in winter the park offers skiing lessons at the Kakškalns ski track. ## 6. THE NEW CASTLE OF SIGULDA, SIGULDA CASTLE DISTRICT

The exterior of the New Castle of Sigulda built by the Knyaz Kropotkin family in 1878 has retained its neo-Gothic style, meanwhile its interior became a pearl of national romanticism in 1937, when it hosted the Latvian Union of Writers and Journalists. Nowadays, the castle district buildings host workshops and salons of craftsmen and artists, where new skills can be learnt, and souvenirs can be purchased. ## 10. AIR CABLEWAY. BUNGEE JUMPING. ZĒRGLIS

## 12., 18. SERPENTINE ROADS OF SIGULDA

The historical serpentine road of Krimulda is a popular place for romantic walks from the bridge over the River Gauja to Krimulda Manor. It was built for the first time in 1862 before the visit of Russian Tsar Alexander II. The serpentine road of Sigulda links Sigulda Festivity Square with a bridge over the River Gauja, enabling one to view the unique beauty from another angle. GPS: 57.1699, 24.8305



## 14. BOBSLEIGH AND LUGE TRACK SIGULDA

The Bobsleigh and luge track Sigulda is one of 18 constructions of this type in the world. In comparison with other tracks, this one is unique, since it is accessible for visitors and tourists for attraction rides. International competitions are held at the track every year. Sigulda Municipality can be proud of ranking first in the world by the number of Winter Olympics awards per capita. ## 11., 31. ADVENTURE PARK TARZĀNS

The largest open air adventure park in the Baltic states will entertain the entire family! Here you will find an obstacle course in the trees, a trampoline park, huge swings, a catapult and other attractions. ## 27. FISCHER SKIING CENTRE

The 1.25 km long track is available for roller skiing, skating, Nordic walking, running and laser biathlon, while in winter it is one of the first places in Latvia to enjoy skiing at the only artificially frozen ski track in Eastern Europe. ## 19. GŪTMANIS CAVE AND GAUJA NATIONAL PARK

The largest Baltic cave – grotto is the oldest tourism object in Latvia. Its walls have evidenced multiple events and contain inscriptions dating back to the 17th century. People say that the springs originating at the grotto have healing power. They were once used by a man called “gut mann” to heal people. His name gave the name to the cave. The beautiful story of the Rose of Turaida, who was secretly meeting her beloved Victor near the cave. Gauja National park was founded 45 years ago to protect this and numerous other sandstone outcrops of the Devonian period on the banks of the River Gauja and its tributaries. It is the oldest national park in Latvia and the largest one in the Baltic states. Tourist Information Centre and a paid car park are located at a distance of 300 m from Gūtmanis Cave. ## RECOMMENDED ROUTES:

### CITY ROUTE (5 KM)

Sightseeing objects on the route: Laima Clock and Central Station square, Culture centre “Siguldas devons”, Key Square, Monument to Krišjānis Barons, Sigulda Evangelic Lutheran Church, Sigulda Castle District, Walking stick park, Cableway, Festivity square, Tarzāns adventure park, Baltais Flīgelis concert hall, Bobsleigh and luge track Sigulda.

## ADD TO THE CITY ROUTE:

### THREE CASTLE ROAD (+10 KM)

Sightseeing objects on the route: Cableway, Krimulda Manor and Medieval Castle ruins, Serpentine road, Gūtmanis Cave, Turaida Museum Reserve.

### THE WILD RAVINE OF THE RIVER VĒJUPĪTE AND MOUND PARADĪZES (+5 KM)

Sightseeing objects on the route: Painters’ (Paradise) Hill, Satesele castle hill, Kraukļi Ravine and Cave, Pētera (Peter’s) Cave.

### BEST VIEWPOINTS IN THE PRIMEVAL VALLEY OF THE RIVER GAUJA (+8.5 KM)

Sightseeing objects on the route: Krimulda Manor, Pīķene Cliff, Walking Bridge across the Gauja River, Devil’s Cave Rocks and the cave, Tarzāns adventure park, Bridge across the Gauja River. Supplement the route with sightseeing objects: Keizarskats (Emperor’s View), Fischer Skiing Centre, Keizarkrēsls (Emperor’s Chair), Mežakakiš adventure park, Bobsleigh and luge track Sigulda.
